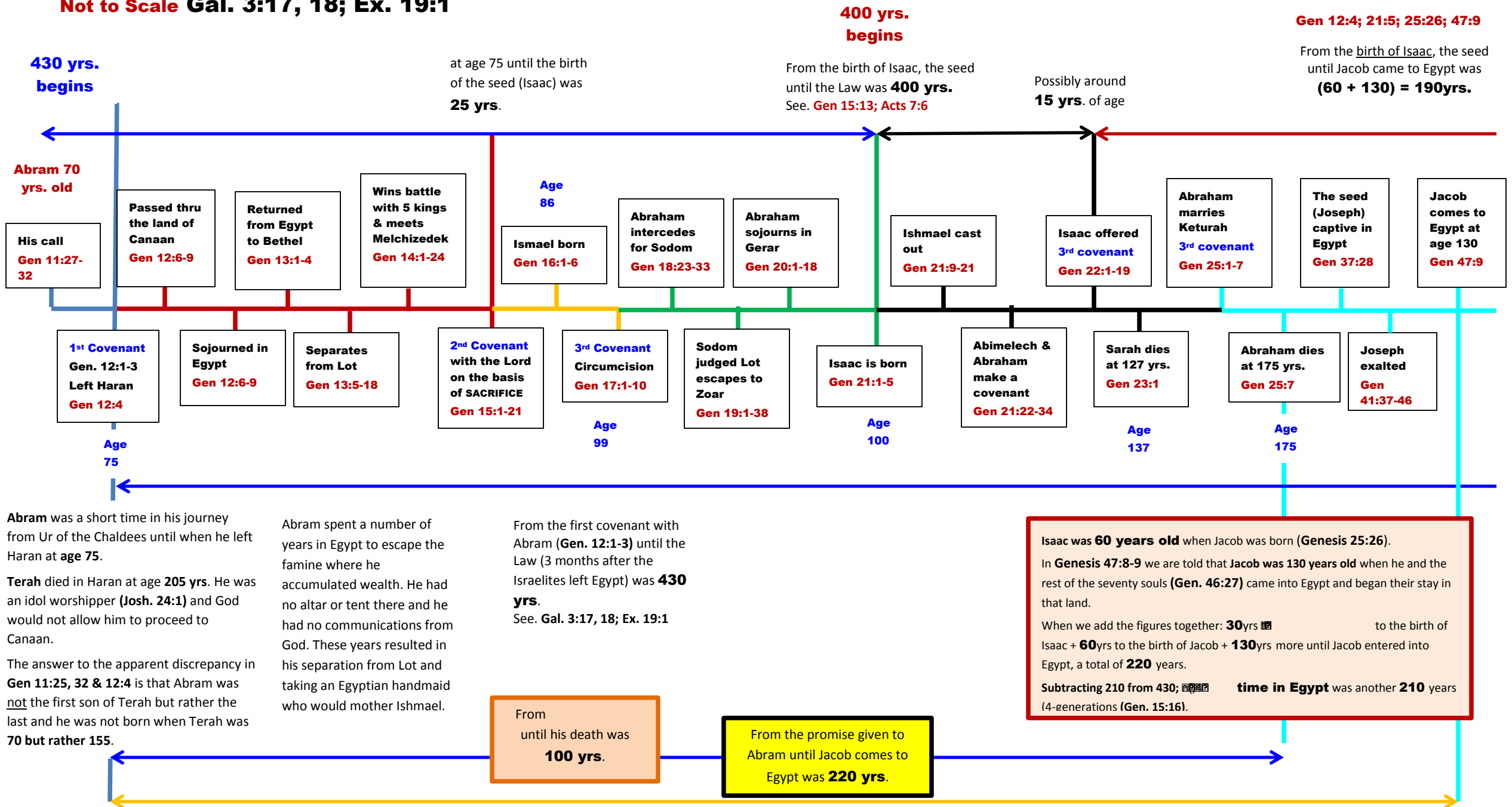


TIMELINE FOR ABRAM (ABRAHAM) from the promise given at age 70 (Gen. 12:1-4) until JACOB ARRIVES IN EGYPT - 220 YEARS

Abram was a short time in his journey from Ur of the Chaldees until when he left Haran at age 75.

Terah died in Haran at age 205 yrs. He was an idol worshipper (Josh. 24:1) and God would not allow him to proceed to Canaan.

The answer to the apparent discrepancy in Gen 11:25, 32 & 12:4 is that Abram was not the first son of Terah but rather the last and he was not born when Terah was 70 but rather 155.

Abram spent a number of years in Egypt to escape the famine where he accumulated wealth. He had no altar or tent there and he had no communications from God. These years resulted in his separation from Lot and taking an Egyptian handmaid who would mother Ishmael.

From the first covenant with Abram (Gen. 12:1-3) until the Law (3 months after the Israelites left Egypt) was **430 yrs.**
See. Gal. 3:17, 18; Ex. 19:1

Isaac was **60 years old** when Jacob was born (Genesis 25:26).
In Genesis 47:8-9 we are told that Jacob was 130 years old when he and the rest of the seventy souls (Gen. 46:27) came into Egypt and began their stay in that land.
When we add the figures together: 30yrs to the birth of Isaac + 60yrs to the birth of Jacob + 130yrs more until Jacob entered into Egypt, a total of **220** years.
Subtracting 210 from 430; **time in Egypt** was another **210** years (4-generations (Gen. 15:16)).
